



AT Tools to Support Reading

Examples only!
Not an exhaustive list.

No Tech Options:

- extra time for completing assignments
- chapter outlines
- text adapted to a lower reading level
- story maps
- strategic reading to locate main ideas

Low Tech Options:

- Color transparencies to increase visual contrast
- Use of a pen light to illuminate reading passage
- Card to isolate one line at a time

High Tech Options:

- Immersive Reader
- Learning Ally/Bookshare
- Text to Speech
- e-books

AT Tools to Support Writing

No Tech Options:

- Reduce near/far point copy work
- Write every other line to increase legibility

Low Tech:

- Pencil grips, highlighters
- Copy of peer or teacher notes

High Tech:

- Microsoft Learning Tools: Dictate, Immersive Reader
- Text prediction
- Change of font, background, text size
